#### Severn Avenue Public School

#### **Current Status**

Severn Avenue Public School is a Gr. JK-6 school offering English programming to 166 students. The school community is very small but is very effective in supporting students and parents who face many systemic barriers to success. Families feel grounded in high expectations that the school has for learning and see the school as an integral part of their children's growing experience.

Enrolment at Severn Avenue PS has declined over time; it is utilized at 44% and projected to slowly decline further over time. The small enrolment for students in the English program creates limitations in timetabling students. The class organization this school year had only one split class at every grade level with the exception of JK/SK and Gr. 3. (14 students). The limitations in timetabling result in less flexibility to regroup children every year based on the dynamics a classroom or individual student needs. Children are often in the same class as a sibling and may remain with the same teacher over years. There is also little flexibility in providing common planning time for teachers.

As evidenced at Woodroffe Avenue PS and Agincourt Road PS (and across the District), there is steady growth in the choice of French Immersion at schools. In reviewing this geographic area, it is necessary to look at the size and location of schools and align those elements with projected or declining enrolments in programs.

#### Proposed Plan for Change

1. Severn Avenue Public School would become a JK-6 Early French Immersion Centre. Students enrolled in the English program at Severn Avenue PS would be directed to D. Roy Kennedy PS or Pinecrest PS, dependent on home location.

#### <u>Learning Enhancements</u>

The proposed plan for change is guided by a number of the overarching principles for all District Pupil Accommodation Reviews.

Firstly, there is a need to align the student population in English and French programs to better optimize resources in this geographic area. The need for more pupil spaces for French Immersion programming is critical given the overcrowding at Woodroffe Avenue PS and the projected growth of the program over time. The Severn Avenue PS site can transform into a new French Immersion centre and provide the capacity for program consolidation in a geographically accessible place for neighboring communities. The proposal also allows for the further consolidation of students who choose to remain in an English only program. This provides a wider opportunity for learners; there is more flexibility in timetabling grades, more opportunity for peer interactions, role modelling and resource accessibility.

Secondly, there is a need to provide a more sustainable, viable program balance in the geographic area in planning for the future. In moving English program students from

Severn Avenue PS to their new home school, every attention will be made in order that student needs are met. The transition plan that is prepared for students will be developed with student and community needs at its base. In providing wider programming possibilities, the needs of individual learners may be supported in a more systemic fashion that can help learners preserve and foster success.

A number of students impacted by this proposal will be redirected to a community school that is closer to their home location. Queensway Terrace North and surrounding area is ripe for housing turn over.

This change in program location will result in Severn Avenue Public School's utilization rate increasing from 45% to 89% with the completed phase-in of students. Ultimately the school is projected to have close to 350 students (2025) based on the redrawing of EFI boundaries in the area.

#### Other Options Considered

A number of other options were considered in the development of this proposal. Other schools in the geographic area that are underutilized (such as Regina Street PS or Pinecrest PS) do not have the capacity to add the 350+ projected student spaces that will be needed to house the EFI program students.

The Severn Avenue PS site itself is large and lends itself to a future addition if there are no other suitable accommodation solutions due to future changes in demographics.

#### <u>Implementation Timelines and Issues</u>


The phased-in introduction of an EFI program at Severn Avenue PS and the movement of its students in the English Program to their new receiving schools would take place in September 2017.

Severn Avenue Public School hosts a Parent and Family Literacy Centre (PFLC). The Ministry of Education is currently working with the municipalities in developing a coordinated approach to how early years programs will be funded and offered. This work is to be done during the coming school year. Until there is an announcement about how locations will be determined for the new Ontario Early Years Children Family Centers, the PFLC at Severn Avenue PS will remain on site.






# SEVERN AVENUE PUBLIC SCHOOL - Per Proposed Plan






### Attachment A: School and Area Land Use Map
